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CALL for *REVIEWS EDITOR* APPLICANTS

Design Issues* welcomes applicants for the *Reviews Editor* position.

The Reviews Editor is responsible for soliciting and managing the reviews (primarily of books and exhibitions) that are published in the journal's quarterly issues. Reviews are a crucial and lively part of the journal, in which current events and recent book publications are critically and insightfully evaluated and are then featured along with scholarly articles.

The Reviews Editor is responsible for anticipating relevant timely book releases, exhibitions, and other events; inviting and managing reviewers; assessing drafts and providing feedback; and approving the final review for the production process. The Reviews Editor participates in monthly, online meetings with the full editorial team. The ideal candidate should have relevant skills to be an editor, have strong communication and organizational skills, and be familiar and engaged with contemporary design discourse. Consistent with the editorial group, there is no remuneration for the position. The selected candidate would serve in the role for one year with a possible subsequent extension.

The Editors of *Design Issues* and MIT Press are committed to equity and diversity and warmly welcome applications from under-represented constituencies. Early career academics are encouraged to apply.

Applicants may email Managing Editor Gail Papay (gail.papay@case.edu) a cover letter that highlights your relevant experience, briefly states what you would bring to this role, and indicates how you might benefit from such a role. Please also attach your CV or resume, a brief bio, and a list of publications. The editorial search committee may request additional relevant materials.

The application deadline is February 15, 2023.
