MIT Press Direct is the most comprehensive digital collection of MIT Press ebooks. The platform hosts more than 3,500 titles, including the open access titles supported by the Direct to Open (D2O) program. Libraries can purchase backlist and archive collections, including subject collections. Libraries can participate in D2O to support open access monographs as well as purchase the 2023 Trade collection.

Please note MIT does not charge for incoming wires. The bank you use to remit a wire transfer payment will make the transfer according to its own routing arrangements. Frontlist Options

The 2023 MIT Press frontlist is available in two collections: our general interest titles are available in the 2023 Trade collection and our monographs and scholarly edited books are available through the D2O program (<https://direct.mit.edu/books/pages/direct-to-open>). D2O participating libraries receive discounting on the 2023 Trade collection. Key subject areas covered include art and architecture, biomedical sciences, business and finance, computer science, cognitive science, design, education, environment, game studies, information sciences, linguistics, neuroscience, new media, and philosophy.

2023 Trade Collection

The 2023 Trade collection features approximately 100 general interest titles, including volumes in the popular MIT Press Essential Knowledge Series.

Direct to Open (D2O)

D2O harnesses the collective power of libraries to support open and equitable access to vital, leading scholarship. Developed over two years with the generous support of the Arcadia Fund, in close collaboration with the library community, Direct to Open:

- Opens access to new MIT Press scholarly monographs and edited collections (~90 titles per year) from 2022 via recurring participation fees.
- Provides participating libraries with term access to backlist/archives (~2,500 titles), which would otherwise be gated.
- Covers partial direct costs for the publication of high-quality works that are also available for print purchase.

In order to ensure that we accommodate researcher needs and library budgets, we are offering libraries the opportunity to support the complete collection, or one of two, non-overlapping subject collections: Humanities & Social Sciences, and STEAM (STEM + Art & Design).

Subject Collection Archives

We offer four subject collection archives that include books on the platform published through 2022. The four subject collections—Economics; Science, Technology, and Society; Philosophy; and Environmental Science—represent core publishing strengths at the Press. Subject collections include leaders in their fields such as Slavoj Žižek, Theodor Adorno, and Ruth Millikan (Philosophy); Stephen S. Schneider (Environmental Science); and Joseph E. Stiglitz (Economics). Each collection is available for purchase.

MIT Press Complete Collection Archives

The 2023 Trade collection and D2O participation come with term access to the corresponding backfile. For libraries and institutions interested in purchasing perpetual access to prior year collections, we offer backlist and archive collections by year.
